ALLOWABLE PER CITY ORDINANCE NO. 3671 C.S. § 8-2.03 (C)(1)

The City of Monterey has established a rental inventory requiring landlords to register their rental units and provide other information to the City on an annual basis. The registration fees collected pursuant to this Article will be used to fund the creation and maintenance of the rental inventory as well as to provide services, including referrals to mediation and legal services, education opportunities, and landlord/tenant resources, to Landlords and Tenants in the City. This Article supports the City's housing goals and protects public health, safety, and welfare for Monterey residents. **The City of Monterey allows, but does not require**, landlords to recover up to 50% (no more than \$25 per year) of the registration fee from their tenant. Landlords shall use this form to notify Tenants that they have chosen to recover up to \$25 of the \$50 per year registration fee from their tenant, and this form serves as a notice of charges due.
