#### Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP) Summary

The NIP has a diversity of projects representing a wide array of community needs. The NIP has forty-one (41) funded projects totaling \$3,442,950, and one unfunded "Cut-off" project selected for the 2015/2016 Fiscal Year.

NIP projects include: Clearing brush in greenbelt areas for fire safety, storm drain and other drainage work, street widening and repaving, sidewalks and ADA curb ramps, a radar speed sign, maintenance and upgrades to various City buildings, parks, playgrounds, and medians, and a regional water recovery study.
