UNIQUE PARTNERSHIP TO BRING EXCITING ATTRACTION TO OLD CAPITOL SITE PARKLAND April 1, 2024, 12 p.m. Press Conference at City Hall


Monterey, Calif. – The City of Monterey is busy preparing the Old Capitol Site Master Plan, and we appreciate all the feedback we received from residents through the recent survey and town hall. After reviewing the ideas for types of uses for the newly acquired parkland, and with much deliberation, City Council and staff are thrilled to announce a new partnership with International Dinosaurus Technologies, Inc. (InDin) that will bring to the Peninsula a first of its kind dinosaur amusement park!

"The Old Capitol Site is a special area of significance," explained City Manager Hans Uslar. "It is one of the few remaining Monterey Pine Forests, a critically important ecological resource, and it is our responsibility to do something just as significant for the delight of the entire region."

The newest attractions, featuring the gentle Brontosaurus, the high flying Pterodactylus, and the roaming Triceratops from Isla Nublar and Isla Sorna will be on full display through the 135 acres, with an anticipated opening day announced by summer. A press conference with InDin Dr. Malcolm Smith, Dr. Sallie Ettles, and Dr. Grant Allen will be held today, Monday, April 1st, at 12:00pm at Monterey City Hall steps at 580 Pacific Street, where we will have on photo display, the newest featured reptile attraction, the Rojanasathaurus.
