

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-10**

**AUTHORIZING CONCEPTUAL APPROVAL FOR THE NAVAL POSTGRADUATE  
SCHOOL TO ALLOW THE PUBLIC USE OF ITS BERTHS AT  
THE COAST GUARD PIER**

Whereas the Naval Postgraduate School has long supported a Navy Sailing Program for its sailors located at the Coast Guard pier, and the City of Monterey has supported that program by allowing the use of its State granted tidelands for the placement of the Navy berths, and severe budget constraints have placed in jeopardy the ability of the Navy to continue funding its sailing school, and

Whereas the Navy desires to negotiate with a concessionaire the potential terms of an agreement which would allow the Navy Sailing Program to continue while also allowing the general public to utilize the Navy boats and berths, and the City of Monterey must be assured that all of its interests, the use of City property, and any potential liabilities are addressed, and

Whereas, the Naval Postgraduate School cannot begin to negotiate an agreement without at least conceptual approval from the City for general public use of its docks.

NOW ,THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY to grant conceptual approval for the use of Naval Postgraduate School docks by the general public. Granting this conceptual approval will allow the Naval Postgraduate School to negotiate an agreement with a concessionaire, the terms of which will not be final without City Council review and approval.


