**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CALIFORNIA MARITIME
“AROUND-THE-HORN” TRANSPORTATION HISTORY BILL**

WHEREAS the City of Monterey is proud of her long and distinguished maritime heritage as a port of call to visiting vessels from all regions of the world; and

WHEREAS the goal of the California Maritime History Resolution and of the California Maritime Center is to benefit all Californians by developing a complete history of California using a historical study model, based on geography, climate, botany, transportation and human settlement/migration; and

WHEREAS this historical study model results in a global understanding of the economic impact and cultural settlement role of maritime trade routes from past to present; and

WHEREAS the intent of the California Maritime History Resolution being introduced in both the California Assembly and Senate is to serve as a catalyst to encourage scholars and agencies to collaborate in their research and develop a fair and complete, official state historical policy, including the geographical and historic influences of our characteristics seafaring populations, are now being overlooked.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Monterey supports the California Maritime History Resolution to recognize the Pacific maritime transportation route of sailing around the horn of South America to California as being an essential educational component of its official interpretative history.
