

RESOLUTION NO. 06-03

RESOLUTION VACATING A PORTION OF LOMITA STREET, IN THE CITY OF MONTEREY, COUNTY OF MONTEREY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ACCORDING TO THE MAP OF THE DOUD TRACT FILED FEBRUARY 18, 1888 IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY OF RECORDER OF SAID COUNTY IN VOLUME 1, PAGE 60 OF MAPS OF CITIES AND TOWNS,

WHEREAS, For a period of over five consecutive years, Lomita Street has been impassable for vehicular travel, and

WHEREAS, No public money was expended for maintenance on Lomita Street during such period, and


WHEREAS, Lomita Street is an excess right-of-way not required for street or highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY, that pursuant to Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 4, that the portion of Lomita Street described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, is hereby vacated and that as of the date this resolution is recorded, the affected portion of the existing Street no longer constitutes a public Street.
