PREVIOUSLY APPROVED CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES  
FOR THE MONTEREY SPORTS CENTER (MSC) NATATORIUM AND LOCKER ROOMS

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2008, the Council of the City of Monterey approved Resolution No. 08-040 C.S. Amending Resolution 07-007 and the Harris & Associates Contract for Program Management Services, authorizing funding of Construction Management and Inspection Services for the Monterey Sports Center Natatorium and Locker Rooms Renovation Project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Monterey has determined, given that the beneficial occupancy date for the Natatorium and Locker Rooms Renovation Project was established as May 16, 2008, 28 days beyond the completion date in the original Harris and Associates contract proposal, an amendment to the Harris and Associates contract for Program Management Services was needed to provide additional Construction Management and Inspection Services to May 18, 2008 is in the best interest of the City;


