



CALL FOR PERFORMERS

The Colton Hall Museum and Cultural Arts Commission of the City of Monterey is calling for artists to perform as part of the year 2010 Colton Hall Music series.

We present three acoustic concerts per year, which include classical or other acoustic music selections, attracting many local music enthusiasts. The hall seats approximately 120 people and is lit by candlelight, which creates a unique ambiance in the City's most prominent historic building. The concerts are held January through March 2010, and scheduled midweek. The concerts begin at 7:30 p.m. and last for approximately one hour including an optional intermission. **Due to the increased costs of renting and delivering pianos to the upstairs hall, the commission has elected not to have piano concerts as part of this series. Requests for piano concerts will not be accepted.**
