description_of_improvement: Improve the drainage around the monument; clean monument of soot, dirt, and biological growth; remove sections of unstable mortar and install french drain for better drainage

description_of_need_benefits_continued1: This is part of the ongoing project of stewardship of existing city monuments and outdoor art. Due to contingencies associated with the conservation and treatment of the Bertold and Serra Monuments funding was not sufficient to complete the Sloat repairs. A thorough inspection, as part of the original NIP request, provided a detailed condition assessment and treatment plan for the Sloat Monument. The Sloat Monument overlooks the Monterey Bay and is one of the most prominent landmarks in the City of Monterey. The corner stone was laid in 1896 and the monument completed in 1910.

description_of_need_benefits_continued2: The repair is consistent with the city council's strategic plan of appropriately preserving, promoting and maintaining our historic, cultural and environmental

comments: This was part of a 2006 NIP project and supported by the neighborhoods at that time.

comments2: Remaining monies from the 2006 project was returned to NIP in 2008 and this project was recommended to become phase 2 of the monument repairs
