(2.653 - 1.533 = 1.120 the 1.533 goes to Econ & Env Sustainability)
- (D) Youth Center Expansion allocation of 1.060 reallocated to new Econ & Environ Sustainability category. This amount will be replenished using WOB water when Youth Center is approved to proceed.
- (E) .610 acre feet has been allocated for five years to CalTrans for Highway 1 median landscaping and a portion will be returned to the public projects category in 2009.
